- * end in self/selves
- * must always have an antecedent that they agree with
in number, person, and gender

	<u>Singular</u>	<u>Plural</u>
First	myself	ourselves
Second	yourself	yourselves
Third	himself herself itself	themselves

An **INTENSIVE** pronoun is used to emphasize, or intensify the preceding noun or pronoun.

I **myself** have read many stories about survival.

A **REFLEXIVE** pronoun is usually the object of a verb (DO or IO) or preposition (OP)

DO

Len bought **himself** a survival book at the bookstore.
