*A **pronoun** is a word used in place of a **noun**.

*Pronouns help avoid repetition.

*The word a pronoun refers to is called the **antecedent**.

| 2nd (spoken to) | you | you |
| 3rd(spoken about) | he, she, it | they |

| | <u>Male</u> | <u>Female</u> | <u>Neutral</u> |
|----------------|-------------|---------------|----------------|
| Subject | he | she | it, they |
| Object | him | her | it, them |
